1. PUBLIC HEARING:

A. 8:00 AM: Request from M&M Plus Enterprises, d/b/a Desperados, 246 Main St., for an Annual All Alcohol Restaurant License, Robert Mazzu, Manager

Chairman Rempell opened the public hearing at 8 am for a request from M&M Plus Enterprises, d/b/a Desperados, 246 Main St., for an Annual All Alcohol Restaurant License, Robert Mazzu, Manager. Mr. Mazzu said he purchased the business in January of 2012, and because Mr. Atwell, whose name is on the liquor license, is no longer involved with the business, Mr. Mazzu must apply for a new license. On December 10, 2012, Mr. Mazzu surrendered his liquor license to the Police Chief and has not since sold liquor. Mr. Rempell strongly advised Mr. Mazzu to take the TIPS course along with his staff. Mr. Sheldon said that when Desperados receives its liquor license, quoting absent selectman Jane Allen, anyone ordering alcohol should be carded unless “they have wrinkles”.

Mr. Costley moved to close the public hearing. Mr. Sheldon seconded and the motion carried 4-0-0.

Mr. Costley moved to approve the request from M&M Plus Enterprises, d/b/a Desperados, 246 Main St., for an Annual All Alcohol Restaurant License with Robert Mazzu as Manager. Mr. Sheldon seconded and the motion carried 4-0-0.
