A scholarship opportunity for Williamstown residents

For town residents enrolling or enrolled in accredited academic programs in the 2019-20 school year, including

- **non-traditional students**, who are going back to school or continuing their education, and
- **traditional students**, who will have completed at least one year of education post high school by Fall 2018.

These modest scholarships are intended to help support residents' educational goals, enhance their skills, or prepare them to re-enter the workforce. Current high school seniors, because they are eligible for other scholarships, will not be considered.
