



How Do You Want to Vote in the State Primary Election?

Vote by Mail

Early Voting by mail will be available for all 2020 elections

Deadline to register to vote and change party enrollment for the State Primary:

Saturday, August 22, 2020

Deadline to apply for a vote by mail ballot before the State Primary:

Wednesday, August 26, 2020 – 5 PM

Deadline to apply for an absentee ballot before the State Primary:

Monday, August 31, 2020 – 12 PM

There are two ways to apply for a vote by mail ballot:

Fill out the postcard you received from the Secretary of State's Office and return (you can drop in the mail (postage paid) or put in the mail slot at town hall)
