

The Transfer Station is open Tuesday-Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Closed Sunday, Monday, and holidays.

The Transfer Station is open to Williamstown residents only. Vehicles must bear a Transfer Station sticker and waste must be in approved transparent bags.

Temporary Commercial stickers are available on a *per job* basis when refuse is from a Williamstown residence.

Vehicle stickers are \$120 per year or \$20 per month. Stickers for additional vehicles in the same household may be purchased only at the same time as the first sticker for \$15 each.

Bags are \$2.50 each for thirty-three gallon capacity and \$1.25 each for thirteen gallon capacity.

Stickers and bags may be purchased at the Collector's office in the Municipal Building. Bags are also available at Wild Oats, Aubuchon and Stop & Shop in North Adams .

Household Hazardous Waste can be disposed of on specific collection days which are announced throughout the year.

MASSACHUSETTS STATE REGULATION 310 CMR 19.017 PROHIBITS THE DISPOSAL OR TRANSFER FOR DISPOSAL OF THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS IN YOUR REGULAR HOUSEHOLD WASTE.

- ASPHALT PAVEMENT, BRICK AND/OR CONCRETE
- CATHODE RAY TUBES
- GLASS CONTAINERS
- LEAD BATTERIES
- LEAVES AND YARD WASTE
- METAL
- METAL CONTAINERS
- RECYCLABLE PAPER
- SINGLE POLYMER PLASTICS (Narrow-neck Plastic Containers)
- WHITE GOODS (i.e. Refrigerators, Washing Machines, Dryers, etc.)
- WHOLE TIRES (at landfills only)
- WOOD (at landfills only)
- LEAD ACID BATTERIES
- CLEAN GYPSUM WALLBOARD

REPLACEMENT STICKERS

In order to obtain a replacement sticker—it is required that you present the old sticker. The original sticker should be scraped from the window of the car and brought to the Treasurer's Office with proof that you have obtained a new vehicle.

You will be charged the current fee for a secondary sticker for a replacement sticker.

If you cannot produce the old sticker, you will have to pay the full-price for a new sticker.

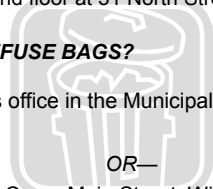

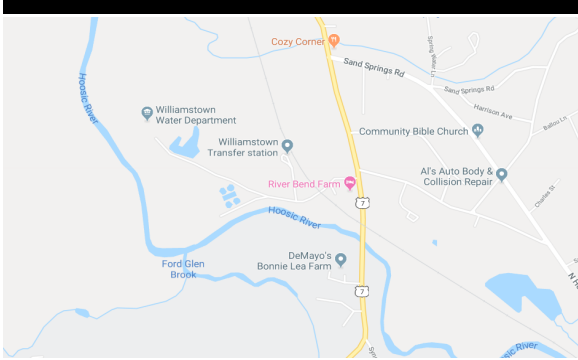

WHAT WE RECYCLE

Paper

Keep paper separate from containers.

Bring in a brown paper bag or box.

No loose papers

- Paperbacks, phone books—
remove covers

- Junk Mail

- Newspaper inserts

- Magazines & catalogs

- Brown paper bags

- White & colored paper

- Corrugated cardboard—
flattened and tape removed

- Boxboard—cereal, shoe, cracker



Containers

Rinse all containers.

Keep separate from paper.

Flatten cans & plastic.

- Glass bottles & jars—all sizes
and colors

- Aluminum, tin/steel cans & lids

Other items

- Fluorescent bulbs

- Scrap metal

- Electronics

- Mercury

Unacceptable items

- Styrofoam

- Plastic Bags

- Soiled Paper or Boxes

- Ceramics, Dishes or Glassware

- *Plastic Planters or Flower Pots*



TIRE DISPOSAL

There is a Tire Collection Trailer located at the Adams Recycling Transfer Station on East Road. A coupon must first be purchased at the Adams Town Hall Treasurers Office .

PAINT COLLECTION

The NBSWMD is not longer conducting Paint Collections. Latex paint, left to dry, can be disposed of in your household waste.



All other paints should be disposed of at the Annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION



NBSWMD hosts a one-day Household Hazardous Waste Collections **most** years.

WHAT TO BRING TO A HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION?

Pesticides, fungicides, herbicides, insect sprays, rodent killers, muriatic acid, flea powder, no-pest strips, chemical fertilizers, lighter fluid, swimming pool chemicals, rust proofers, wood preservatives, wood strippers and stains, paint thinners, oil based paint, varnish, aerosol cans, sealants, adhesives, fiberglass resins, drain cleaners, oven cleaners, floor cleaners, toilet cleaners, carpet cleaners, metal polish, moth balls, chemistry kits, antifreeze, old gasoline, kerosene, brake fluid, transmission fluid, engine degreaser, carburetor cleaner, radiator flusher, roofing tar and non-latex driveway sealer.

WHAT NOT TO BRING? Empty containers, latex paint, household batteries, medical waste, asbestos, fireworks & explosives, road flares, construction debris, used motor oil.

USED MOTOR OIL

A motor oil collection tank is located at the Williamstown Transfer Station. There is no charge, however residents must sign a log and leave their oil with the attendant.
