



How Do You Want to Vote in the State Primary Election?

Vote by Mail

Early Voting by mail will be available for all 2022 elections

Deadline to register to vote and change party affiliation for the State Primary:	Saturday, August 27, 2022 – 5 PM
Deadline to apply for a vote by mail ballot before the State Primary:	Monday, August 29, 2022 – 5 PM
Deadline to apply for an absentee ballot before the State Primary:	Monday, August 29, 2022 – 5 PM

There are two ways to apply for a vote by mail ballot:

Fill out the postcard you received from the Secretary of State's Office and return (you can drop in the mail (postage paid) or put in the drop box at town hall)
