Appointments will be available for Tuesday evening and Saturday mornings. The first session is slated for Tuesday Feb. 7th and the final date is April 18th. As usual, all sessions are one hour appointments. Reservations are required, walk-in arrivals will not be processed.

After your appointment is made, you'll have to pop in and grab a copy of the AARP intake booklet to fill out. I think they had this last year as well, you'll need to bring it with you to your session.

As usual with this program, you'll need to bring all paperwork pertinent to filing your 2022 tax returns. I think that last year a few folks didn't believe me when I said ALL paperwork. And they had to make second appointments to finish the job. Anything that you think just might be relevant, bring it, the Tax Aides will know what's needed. You'll need to bring a copy of last year's tax returns, those would be the ones from 2021 as well.

The good news is that they're planning on being back for the 2023 season. The bad news is that we're not accepting reservations until the week of January 30th. The Tax Aide volunteers need to recertify first...

If you prefer, you can call the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) at BCAC. They are currently accepting appointments. The number for their North Adams office is 413-663-3014. Their season runs from January 31st to April 15th this year.
