Voter Registration & Voting Information

The deadline to register to vote for the Presidential Primary or to change your party affiliation is Saturday, February 24, 2024. The Town Clerk's office will be open between the hours of 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Please note, you only need to register if you aren't currently registered to vote.

The Presidential Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2024 from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Voting will take place in the gymnasium of the Williamstown Elementary School, 115 Church Street. Parking is available in the School Street Lot in the rear of the school (*accessible only from School Street*). Handicapped parking is also available in the School Street lot.

Vote by mail postcards were mailed to voters by the Secretary of State's Office in January. Vote by mail applications are currently available on the Secretary of State's website, https://www.sec.state.ma.us/divisions/elections/download/vote-by-mail-applications/vote-by-mail-paper-application-2023.pdf or by stopping in the office, if you didn't receive, or misplaced your postcard. The election is quickly approaching and **by law**, ballots need to be mailed to you, so you should submit your application soon to allow adequate time for mailing. The deadline to submit your vote by mail application is Tuesday, February 27th at 5:00 PM.
