Vote by Mail

**Deadline to register to vote
for General Election:**

Saturday, October 26, 2024 – 5 PM

**Deadline to apply for a vote by mail
ballot before the General Election:**

Tuesday, October 29, 2024 – 5 PM

There are three ways to apply for a vote by mail ballot:

Fill out the postcard you received from the Secretary of State's Office and return (you can drop in the mail (postage paid) or put in the drop box at Town Hall)

Fill out the paper application if you didn't receive a post card:
