

Berkshire County Boards of Health Association Cooling Assistance Program

With funding from the New England Rural Health Association and the Berkshire Public Health Alliance to address heat emergencies for older adults and other vulnerable people, the Williamstown Board of Health has obtained five small portable air conditioners and five fans to distribute to Williamstown residents at no cost to those at high risk who don't have access to or resources to purchase this equipment.

This program is intended to provide one cool space in a home where residents can retreat during the worst of the heat and humidity.

Eligibility factors include age, disabilities, harder-to-cool homes, and household income.

An application is attached.

Research shows that people over 65, small children, pregnant women, and those with disabilities are more at risk during extended high heat and humidity days and nights. Our bodies become exhausted trying to cool down. Vulnerable, at-risk people need to cool down below 75°F for at least four hours daily to mitigate the causes of heat illnesses.
